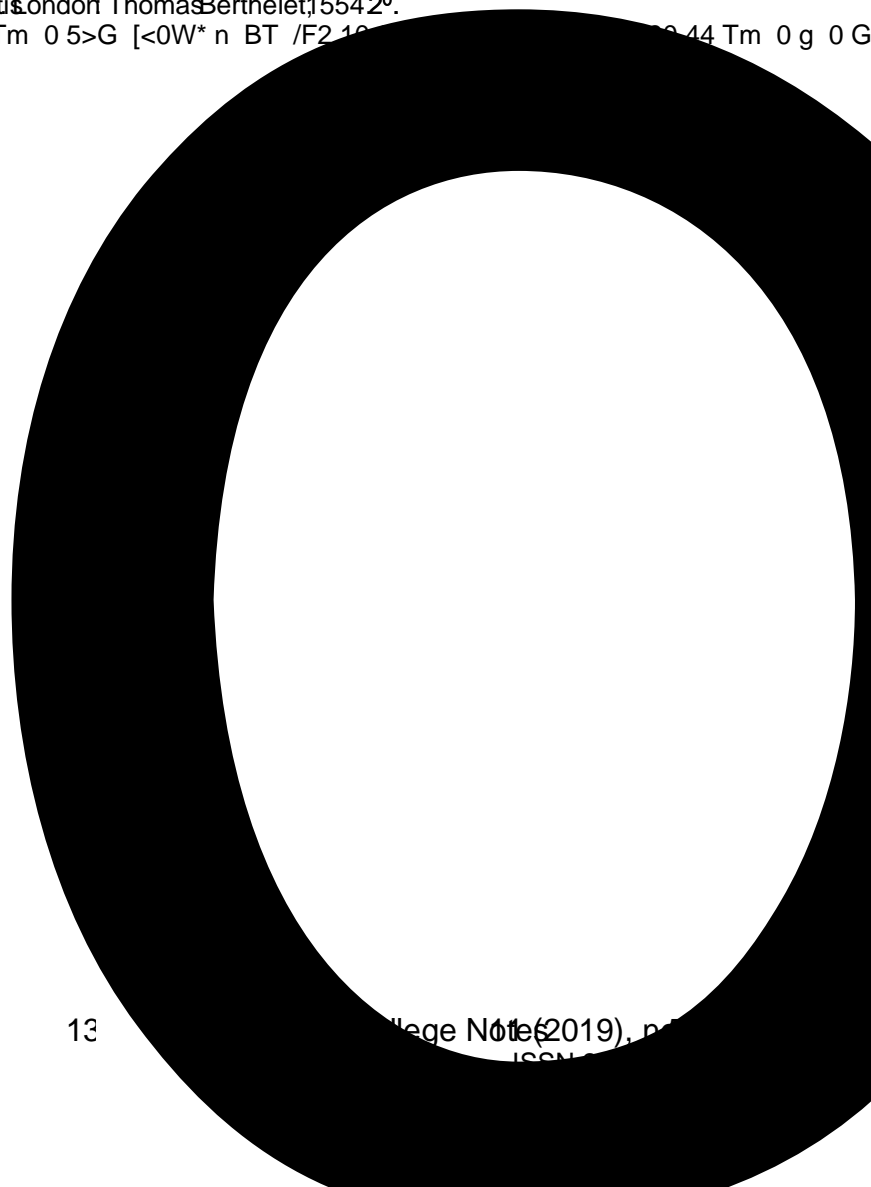

This volume evidently given after 1614, contrary to entry in Benefactors Book.
